The undersigned, being of the age of eighteen years or more, do hereby make and acknowledge the Articles of Incorporation for the purpose of forming a nonprofit corporation under and by virtue of the laws of the State of North Carolina.

- 4. The corporation will have members consisting of one (1) member for each condominium unit at Market Center Towers Condominiums located in High Point, North Carolina.
- Should the corporation be dissolved, any assets of the corporation shall be distributed pursuant Articles 13 and 14 of the "North Carolina NonprofitCorporation Act" as such may from time to time be amended.
- 6. The street address and mailing address for the corporation are the same as the registered office and the principal office of the corporation is located in Guildford County, North Carolina.

- 7. The purposes for which the corporation is organized are:
 - A. To own and/or manage the common areas of Market Center
 Towers Condominiums, High Point, North Carolina and to provide
 general upkeep and maintenance to such common areas; and
 - B.
